



Big Idea

The bible tells us that Jesus came to seek and save the **lost**. The only way you can lose something, is if at one time it belonged to you. This reinforces the truth that God sees all of us as his kids. He created each of us, because he desires a relationship with us. Being lost doesn't necessarily mean geographically lost, it often means that we are lost relationally. It's usually in times the pain or in times of need that we seek God and cry out for Him to help. When we are apart from him, His search for us intensifies because you mean so much to Him. He is passionately, focused on finding the lost and bringing them home. He will leave the ninety-nine righteous, to go and find the one that is lost. Jesus came on a search and rescue mission, to find and restore those who are not with him anymore. And the bible tells us there is more rejoicing in heaven over one sinner who is found, than over the ninety-nine who don't need to repent.

He doesn't care what you've done or what you've become, He just wants you home.
