



Big Idea

You can still experience miracles today! Ps Chris just shared a story from someone who was healed of osteoarthritis last Sunday, while she watched the service online. She watched her toes straighten out and pain left her body while he prayed! At the same time, we have all experienced doubt and unbelief after praying for a miracle that was not answered like we hoped. This can sometimes lead us to think 'God, I know you can do it, but will you do it for me?' To combat fear or doubt in our life, one of the most important things we can do is to surround ourselves with the right people, who speak faith and truth. Relationships are spiritual! The Bible says in 2 Corinthians 6:14-15 says 'Don't be yoked together with unbelievers...what do righteousness and wickedness have in common?'

Here are some ways we can grow our faith and experience miracles in our lives today:

Godly faith still believes, even when it doesn't see it. The bible tells us in Hebrew 11:1 'Now faith is being sure of what we hope for and certain of what we do not see.' The greatest difficulty that you're experiencing right now isn't natural, it's spiritual. For every problem you're facing in the natural, there's a battle going on in the spirit.

Godly faith grows, when you read God's word. We have to fill our mind with God's word and then there will not be room for Satan's lies. "Faith comes by hearing and hearing by the word of God." Roman 10:17 We have to know what Gods word says. Remember, you are what you eat, let's consume His word.

Godly faith persists in spite of what is seen. Regardless of what's going on around us, we have to continue being "faith-full" – in other words we need to stay full of faith. Don't dig up in doubt what you've planted in faith. Failure is not falling down; it's falling down and not getting back up. We will all fall and fail at times. But don't give up, faith gets back up again!

You are the God of miracles and wonders! You still demonstrate your awesome power. Psalm 77:14

Don't ever dig up in doubt, what you planted in faith.
